



The Term "Critical Angle" as used in Radio Wave Propagation.

Basically it is the highest take off angle that will return a radio wave to the Earth. At each frequency there is a maximum angle for which the radio wave can leave the antenna and still be refracted back to Earth by the ionosphere instead of simply passing through it and proceeding out into space. The critical angle changes depending on the ionization of the ionosphere.

Radio waves encountering the ionosphere above the critical angle don't get bent enough to return to Earth. Waves entering at angles below the "critical angle reach the Earth at increasingly greater distances as the launch angle approaches horizontal.
