Whereas: The membership in the Aksarben Amateur radio club is now only around 250, and,

Whereas: It has become increasingly difficult to find people who are willing to hold office, and,

Whereas: It has become impossible at some board meetings to conduct business due to lack of a Quorum,

I hereby move that the number of board members of the Aksarben Amateur Radio Club be reduced to four (4) from the present eight (8). Additionally, that the terms remain at two years with two being elected each year (one half of the board) as it is now.

Further, that those whose terms are not up next year continue to serve their term. In the event that one or two should resign over the interim, they would not be replaced for the remainder of the term. If passed, beginning next year only two would be elected for a two-year term. This would mean that for 2009 there would be 6 board members unless one or more resigned, and in 2010 the then normal four of this motion. Finally, that the by-laws be amended to reflect this motion, if passed.

If passed, The Club direction would be: President, Vice president, four directors at large, and the immediate past president. Secretary and treasurer would be from the board as they are now.

Proposal to change the bylaws 12/14/2007 Revision 3

There are 4 proposals to change the bylaws before the club, these proposed changes follow. Please read through them, and plan on attending the February AARC meeting or sending your ballot back before the deadline to vote on these proposals. If there are any questions, please ask a Board Member or attend one of the January or February meetings.

Change from 8 directors to 4 directors (WB0CMC)

ARTICLE III - OFFICERS AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 6 – DIRECTORS – There shall be eight <u>four</u> directors, two of which shall serve as the secretary and treasurer. They shall <u>be</u> authorized to suggest policies, new projects, programs and to carry on such business as may be required in the general operation of the club. <u>The change from</u> eight to four directors will occur by 2010, for 2009 only 2 directors will be elected, and for 2010 2 will be elected bringing the total to 4 directors. (Change proposed 12/14/2007)

ARTICLE V - MEETINGS AND QUORUMS

Section 2

B. A quorum for the board meeting shall consist of at least five <u>fifty percent</u> <u>of the elected</u> board members. Any vote taken at a board meeting must carry by a simple majority vote of the board in attendance. <u>(Change proposed 12/14/2007)</u>

Modify the procedure to change the bylaws for clarity (N0UP)

ARTICLE VI – AMENDMENTS

Section 1 - PROPOSALS TO AMEND: Proposals for amendments to the bylaws shall be submitted in writing at a membership meeting. The proposals shall <u>be</u> read to the members present, and upon approval of a two-thirds majority of those present, shall be further considered in accordance with Section 2 of this Article. The language of the proposal may be revised so long as the concept and intent of the original proposal is retained. (*Change proposed 12/14/2007*)

Section 2 - APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS:

A. The text of the proposed amendment, after due consideration by the voting board and/or duly appointed committee(s), shall be submitted to the general membership at least 30 days in advance of a vote.

B. A ballot shall be submitted to each member by mail, including any special voting instructions and deadlines. A proposed amendment to the bylaws shall be adopted if approved by two-thirds of ballots returned by the established deadline. A proposed amendment to the bylaws shall be adopted if approved by a simple majority of ballots returned by the established deadline. (Change proposed 12/14/2007, deletion only, no additions)

Proposal to add the Ex-Officio to the Board of Directors (N0UP)

ARTICLE III - OFFICERS AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 2 – PRESIDENT: The PRESIDENT shall preside over all meetings. The president shall be responsible for the orderly conduct of business at all meetings. The president shall appoint all committee chairpersons and shall be an ex officio member of all committees. The president shall be responsible for compliance with the bylaws of the club. The president shall be responsible for insuring that all required club documents are filed with the appropriate agencies, and that the documents are current and up-to-date. The president shall perform all other duties customary to the office of the president. <u>The President shall also be an Ex-Officio member of the Board of Directors the year(s) following the elected term. (Change proposed 12/14/2007)</u>

Section 6 – DIRECTORS – There shall be <u>eight</u> <u>four</u> directors, two of which shall serve as the secretary and treasurer. They shall <u>be</u> authorized to suggest policies, new projects, programs and to carry on such business as may be required in the general operation of the club. <u>The change from</u> <u>eight to four directors will occur by 2010, for 2009 only 2 directors will be</u> <u>elected, and for 2010 2 will be elected bringing the total to 4 directors.</u> (Change proposed 12/14/2007)

<u>Section 6A – Ex-Officio Member – The Last Past President shall serve as a voting member of the Board of Directors. (Addition proposed 12/14/2007)</u>

Proposal to correct typo (N0UP)

ARTICLE V - MEETINGS AND QUORUMS

A. A quorum shall consist of a minimum of ten <u>per cent</u> (10%) of total voting membership to include at least two board members. (*Typo* repair proposed 12/14/2007)
