A QSO party is a contest to see how many Amateur Radio stations from outside of Nebraska can QSO with stations inside Nebraska, and Nebraska stations to QSO with stations outside of the state! For those of you without an HF station, find a friend that will let you use his station or be the control operator while you make contacts. You'll be meeting other amateurs from all around the world during the 2006 Nebraska QSO Party.
